The International Behavioural and Neural Genetics Society was established in 1996 to promote growth of research in the field of neural behavioral genetics. For the past 25 years the annual meeting has attracted participants drawn from multiple countries and included a scientific program of plenary lectures, broadly themed symposia, selected talks, award ceremonies, workshops, and poster sessions.

A diverse range of topics will cover aspects of behavioral neuroscience, genetics, epigenetics and genomics and related -omics fields, molecular biology and behavior across humans and diverse model organisms.

Venue information

<u>Western University</u> ranks among the top research-intensive universities in Canada and has a strong neuroscience focus. The university's <u>Brain and Mind Center</u> was formed in 2011 and consists of more than 100 scientists using diverse approaches to study cognitive processes in an integrative manner. The more recent <u>Western Institute for Neuroscience</u> brings together an additional 200 members with diverse perspectives, skills and infrastructure to unlock the mysteries of the brain for societal benefit.

The conference facilities at Western University are state of the state with ample exhibit and meeting space (links below). In addition to the main meeting room, there are multiple breakout rooms, a designated poster presentation area, full in-house catering, and on-site accommodations. Exhibitor tables will be centrally located to maximize exposure and interaction with attendees.

The entire meeting will take place in one building, North Campus building, on the ground floor. There is an atrium (TA 104 on the linked map) where the posters will stay, and places for tables for exhibitors just outside of the doors to the lecture hall (classroom 113) where the talks will take place.
